CCP COURSE FORMULA SHEET

Determine the amount of college courses a student can take in an academic year:

Students cannot exceed full-time status while participating in CCP courses.

Full time status is 30 college credit hours per academic year and not more than 120 college credit hours in high school.

Calculate full-time status as follows:

- 1. Determine student's number of high school ONLY credits.
- 2. Multiply that number by 3, and
- 3. Subtract the result from the number 30.
- 4. That number is the total number of college credits that CCP student may earn that academic year.

Example:

Student is taking 5.5 credits for high school credit only for the year - multiply by 3

Subtract total from 30

30 - 16.5 = 13.50 -This is the most that the student can take in additional college course work for the academic year.
