A Note from the Director

I am sure you have heard the cliché, "Nothing is certain but death and taxes." Well, if I may be so bold, I will add another certainty we all experience in life...letting go. No one understands more than parents how hard it is to let go and we have to do it multiple times throughout our lives with our most precious gift: our children. 

McCarthy also decorated the Zangmeister Cancer Center, in Columbus, for the fourth year and River Valley Mall, for the third year and the Polaris Mall.




