6th & 7th graders have completed "Grid Drawing", clay whistles and are currently working on "Cubism":












8th graders successfully completed "Grid Drawing", "Modern Sculpture", and are currently working on the Cubists Art movement inspired by Pablo Picasso










High School Art Class:

High School Art 1 & 2 are starting to develop acrylic painting techniques and "Advanced Art" has begun Oil Painting:


