STUDENT PHONE UPDATES - The FCA School Board has approved revisions to the current **student cell phone policy**. The revisions were made to limit distractions to students while they are at school and to more clearly define when and why students can access their cell phones and other devices during the school day. We acknowledge that technology continues to play an important role in education; however, we believe that some cell phone usage has become distracting to our students' educational focus. In addition, I would like to encourage every family to establish a child/parent internet contract and to consider some sort of internet accountability software, such as Covenant Eyes. In my experience as an educator, I have had many conversations with parents who are looking for solutions on how to make their children's internet experience safer. FCA has protective filters in place; however, when students elect to use their own data plan instead of FCA Wi-Fi, our filters are bypassed. Our goal is to continue to partner with parents to provide the safest and best quality education possible.

- Cell phones may not be used during the school day other than before homeroom, during lunch, or with specific instructions from an instructor.
