<u>Birthday Book Club</u>

The FCA Birthday Book Club allows elementary children to choose a book from a collection of new books available in our library. A book plate with the child's name and birthdate will be placed inside the book. The student will have the opportunity to be the first student to check out that book. When returned, the book will become a permanent part of our library collection. Once each month, students with a birthday that month, who joined the club, will be invited to a short birthday party in the library where they will receive a cupcake and a small gift. Students with birthdays in June, July, and August will have their celebration in May. To join, the cost is \$15. Forms were sent home last week and may be picked up in the elementary office.
