

Re-enrollment has begun!

Re-enrollment for the 2024-2025 school year opened Feb. 1. Your student's Back to School Enrollment letter has been mailed with instructions and individual student ID and access key. Special Offer: If you re-enroll your student(s)by March 1, the \$200 per student (\$300 family max) enrollment fee is waived!

Drop off and Pick up Traffic Pattern

During drop-off (7:35-8:00am) and pick-up (2:45-3:05pm), the traffic pattern in our parking lot is one-way. Enter only from Whittier Drive by the playground and exit only onto Columbus St. as you make a counter-clockwise route around the building. Please do not enter or exit at other random spots and cut across lanes or parking areas. Keep kids safe!

Standardized Testing (3rd - 8th Grades)

Standardized testing will occur during the week of Apr. 15-19 for students in grades 3-8. The End of Course State Testing for Algebra I, Geometry, English Language Arts II, Biology and US History will also take place during that week. Because we want your child to do their very best, we ask that students get a good night's sleep and arrive on time to school having had a good breakfast. If at all possible, please try to refrain from scheduling appointments on these dates.
